MINUTES

Chairperson Whittenburg called the meeting to order @ 5:30pm.

All members were present. Also present were Mayor Graham, Phillip Stuckert, Victor Lay, Chuck Downham

Chairperson Whittenburg called the meeting to order at 5:30.

Motion to approve February minutes was made and seconded. Minutes were approved 7-0.

Agenda item 1- Hwy 31 widening update: No new updates

Agenda item 2- Discuss Access Management Plan for South Port Royal Rd between Saturn Parkway and Kedron Rd.

Motion to recommend adoption of plan was made by Alderman Gavigan and seconded by Alderman Fitterer.

Motion passed 7-0

Agenda item 3- Discuss BOMA Resolution 18-34 amending the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (NTCP) to include low impact speed bumps. Presentation of resolution was made by City Administrator Victor Lay discussing the program and how HOA's can request consideration for speed bumps. TAC made a recommendation to the BOMA to adopt the amendment with the stipulation that the traffic volume threshold would be set at 150 vehicles per hour for 20 hours per 24hour period. This recommendation came by way of a motion made by Mr. Terry Love and seconded by Mr. Matt Koss. Motion passed 7-0

Agenda item 4- Planning Commission/BOMA transportation related updates discussion: Chairman Whittenburg began a discussion regarding having items that will be presented to the Planning Commission and or BOMA that have an impact on transportation/traffic be brought before the TAC for discussion so that we can give our collective thoughts and advice/recommendation to the appropriate body. He had 4 examples of recent items that would have been good for TAC to have had an opportunity to discuss. A discussion followed amongst the TAC members where the majority consensus was that the members of TAC would like to have information regarding any "major" traffic issues before the PC and

BOMA so that we could give a recommendation.


Agenda item 5- Discussion on transit projects and opportunities: Terry Love updated the committee on his work with Jamie Page regarding an informational and educational web page for the city to utilize in getting alternate transit/commuter ideas out to the citizens of Spring Hill.

Agenda item 6- Striping /Turn lanes/ Signage Improvements: Mr. Doug Holtz suggested revisiting the idea of "No turn on red" signs at certain intersections along Hwy 31 during certain times of the day to assist with traffic flow.

There were a couple of citizen comments made regarding Hwy 396 and Port Royal Rd and the traffic signal at Port Royal and Buckner Ln.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Holtz and seconded by Mr. Love.
