OFFICER SURVIVAL TACTICS FOR PATROL

THIS IS A "CONTINUING TRAINING" COURSE

The Tennessee Tactical Officers Organization will be conducting an Officer Survival Tactics course at the Spring Hill Police Department, Spring Hill, TN. This is a 2-day 20+ hour course. This training is available to all law enforcement personnel, certain security personnel, and military. This course will give the student a better understanding of officer survival tactics and techniques.

- 3 SHOW SAFE WEAPONS AND MUZZLE DISCIPLINE WHILE CONDUCTING TRAINING

COURSE LEARNING OBJECTIVES / SCOPE

This course is designed to advance the knowledge and familiarization the student has dealing with officer survival and safety tactics. It is designed to instruct the student in various tactics and techniques that have proven to be effective in real life situations. Each student will also learn the importance of continued education and training in this discipline. In this course, the student will be required to demonstrate his/her proficiency in the use of the handgun as well as other weapons in the use of force continuum. Proficiency will be determined by the proper use of qualified course instructors and their expertise/judgment, proficiency courses and drills, and student demonstration exercises. Students must understand this is a performance based course and will require students to demonstrate a specific level of proficiency. Students who fail any course requirement will not pass the course and will not receive a certificate of completion. Individuals who become safety hazards will be asked to leave and no refunds will be given once the course begins. You will only be given one attempt to pass the scenario and application drills along with any proficiency tests which must occur in the same day and time frame. Not everyone can operate effectively under stress and perform properly in certain enforcement environments and the Tennessee Tactical Officers Organization will only give certificate of completions to those who meet this strict standard of training. There are no exceptions given.

This course is specifically designed for law enforcement and security personnel.

AFTER SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THIS COURSE, THE STUDENT SHOULD BE ABLE TO:

- 1 Demonstrate a better understanding of the officer survival tactics mentioned in this course
- 2 Understand the various situations and incidents that are officer survival issues
- 3 Understand and be able work side-by-side with other officers during an officer safety incident
- 4 Successfully identify/recognize dangers and threats during a critical incident
- 5 Properly apply preventative practices that can minimize the officer's likelihood of becoming harmed
- 6 Understand the various forms of stress that effect officers both in critical incidents and normal police activity
- 7 Continue to share information throughout the state of Tennessee to other law enforcement officers in the membership to help each other stay alive and survive.
