

RESOLUTION NO. 96-76

**A RESOLUTION TO PERMIT HIGHERS, KOONCE & ASSOCIATES, ENGINEERS, TO SURVEY, DEVELOP A SITE PLAN, PREPARE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS, AND BID THE SOUTH SIDE WATER TANK SEPARATELY AND JOINTLY WITH THE NORTH SIDE WATER TANK FOR THE SUM OF \$4,000.00 TO BE DRAWN FROM WATER/SEWER DEPRECIATION FUNDS**


**Whereas**, the Town of Spring Hill has plans to construct a water tank for constant fire flow and storage for future growth in the Mahlon Moore Road area on the south side of Town;

**Whereas**, a donation of a 250,000 gallon tank was made to Spring Hill by a donor in Franklin, Tennessee, provided the Town would move the tank upon request and that request has now been made; and

**Whereas**, a north side tank is to be constructed in early 1997 and the possibility now exists to jointly bid the two tanks for possible cost savings.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE** that Highers, Koonce & Associates, Engineers, is authorized to proceed with the site selection, site survey, plat and deed recording, construction documents and bidding of the south side water tank both as a joint bid with the north side tank and as a separate bid. Funds for this design and bid work, in the sum of \$4,000.00, are to be taken from water/sewer depreciation funds. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen will decide after bids are properly received if both water tanks will be constructed as a single contract.
