


RESOLUTION 04-18

WHEREAS, the County Commissions of Williamson County and Maury County is, or will be, seeking to conduct a public referendum for the approval of an increase in the local option sales tax; and


WHEREAS, the County Commissions are, or will be, asking all municipalities within the County to forego using their share of the proceeds, and instead, allowing the Counties to keep all proceeds of the increase and earmark it for public schools;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that any proceeds which the City is entitled to from an increase in the local option sales tax shall not be retained by the Williamson County Government or the Maury County Government, whichever the case may be, for any purpose whatsoever.
