

RESOLUTION 06-01

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A BILL IN THE
TENNESSEE STATE LEGISLATURE TO CHANGE THE ELECTED TERM OF THE
MAYOR TO A TWO (2) YEAR TERM**

WHEREAS, the current length of time the Mayor is elected to serve is four
(4) years; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's term of office does not need to correspond to the
length of terms for the Board of Aldermen which is four (4) years

NOW, THEREFORE Be It Resolved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen
of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the City Attorney is authorized to
prepare and file any and all documents necessary to change the term of office of
the Mayor to a two (2) year term beginning with the next election in April, 2009.
