

RESOLUTION 07-48

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen, the Tennessee Legislature enacted Title 13, Part 4, Chapter 103, which gives powers to municipalities under the authority of the Planning Commission to adopt and provide for the enforcement and administration of subdivision regulations and long range transportation plans, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has adopted a Major Thoroughfare Plan with an amendment incorporating the Commonwealth Drive alignment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen, intends to adopt the City of Spring Hill Major Thoroughfare Plan with an amendment incorporating the Commonwealth Drive alignment and having a public hearing on the Major Thoroughfare Plan with an amendment incorporating the Commonwealth Drive alignment and the Roadway Design Guidelines at the City of Spring Hill Planning Commission on August 13, 2007, per the requirements of TCA 13-303 and 13-603 and having considered all comment and evidence,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to 13-4-202, TCA, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen adopts the Major Thoroughfare Plan with an amendment incorporating the Commonwealth Drive alignment, to be effective on October 15, 2007 for all subdivision plat submittals that have not received final site plan approval.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, on the 15th day of October, 2007.


