**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN
OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE
REQUESTING THE MAURY COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION
TO EXTEND VOTING TIMES**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee would formally request that the Maury County Election Commission extend the hours for voting to 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.;

WHEREAS, that such extension of voting time would allow voting citizens an opportunity to cast their votes on their way to work; and

WHEREAS, the extra hour of voting time would allow greater access and flexibility for citizens wishing to exercise their voting rights and privileges.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the Maury County Election Commission consider extending the hours of voting time to 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. in an effort to accommodate the schedules of citizens desiring to vote. Passed and adopted on November 19, 2007.




