

**RESOLUTION 07-59**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PROCEED WITH THE FILING OF A CONDEMNATION ACTION TO ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY EASEMENTS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE MCCORMACK CREEK SEWER PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, there is a public necessity for the construction of certain sewer lines for the McCormack Creek Sewer project and that the City Attorney has been in negotiations to obtain such easements without the necessity of filing a condemnation action; and

**WHEREAS**, those discussions and negotiations have not been productive up to this point and it has become necessary for the City to acquire such easements for the public use and public good of all the citizens of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee that the City Attorney be hereby authorized to acquire all remaining easements, by means of condemnation if necessary, to complete the McCormack Creek Sewer project at a cost not to exceed \$15,000.00.


