Chairman Pat Campbell, called the meeting to order. Present were: Ron Hankins, Gwynne Evans, Ray Williams, and L.T. Anderson.


Chairman Campbell: First on the agenda is a request from Bruce Scotten to allow a mobile home as a second residence at 405 Alexander Blvd.

Charles Brown stated that the Zoning Ordinance says that there can only be one residence per lot with one exception. The Board of Zoning Appeals can grant a variance for one year and can extend it one additional year if approved by this Board.

L.T. Anderson moved to allow Mr. Scotten to put a mobile home on his lot as a second residence, on Alexander Blvd. Motion seconded by Gwynne Evans. Unanimous.
