**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PARTICIPATION IN THE PROPERTY
CONSERVATION MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Spring Hill have entrusted this administration with the care and custody of city-owned property; and

WHEREAS, all efforts shall be made to protect city-owned property from various perils that may arise; and

WHEREAS, Public Entity Partners seeks to encourage members with property coverage to develop and implement a property conservation program by offering the Property Conservation Matching Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill now seeks to participate in this important program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mayor and Alderman of the City of Spring Hill authorizes the Mayor as follows:

1. That the City of Spring Hill is hereby authorized to submit the application for the “Property Conservation” Matching Grant Program through the Loss Control Department of Public Entity Partners (PEP)
2. That the City of Spring Hill is hereby authorized to accept the award of the “Property Conservation” Matching Grant through Public Entity Partners.
3. That the City is further authorized to provide a matching sum as follows: \$3,014.25 from the Police Department, \$3,014.25 from the Streets Department- 110-43100-265, and \$6,028.50 from the Parks Department – 110-44700-261 to serve as a match for any monies provided by this grant.

PURPOSE:

To authorize the City of Spring Hill to participate in the Property Conservation Matching Grant Program through the Loss Control Department of Public Entity Partners.

BACKGROUND:

Public Entity Partners provides grant money annually to fund projects that protect assets of member cities. The City has participated in this Property Conservation Grant in previous years with much success in protecting assets throughout Spring Hill.

Previous years grant funds have been used to secure Rippavilla with new gates, as well as fund security cameras at the library. This year, we would like to apply for this grant to fund security cameras to monitor the impound lot, the rear gate of the Public Works/Wastewater Treatment campus and the skate park.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

\$12,057.00 (\$5,000 match/reimbursement from PEP) Split between Police Department (\$3,014.25), Streets Department- 110-43100-265 (\$3,014.25) and Parks 110-44700-261(\$6,028.50).
