PURPOSE:

The purpose of this resolution is to authorize to place two station lawn mowers to be sold on Gov Deals. The mowers have become unreliable and have been replaced with new ones.

BACKGROUND:

We replaced both mowers this past month. The walk behind was at fire station 3 and is an older mower. It is also difficult for most employees to use. The Cub Cadet zero-turn that was assigned to fire station 2 has issues annually that require parts and maintenance. We checked with other departments in the city to see if they could use them.
