**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF A VEHICLE
FROM GOVDEALS FOR ADMINISTRATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill staff frequently utilizes city owned vehicles for the purpose of city-related duties; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to purchase a used vehicle from GovDeals of which it is a member; and

WHEREAS, staff requests authorization to purchase a used vehicle in a not to-exceed amount of \$20,000; and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase will be made from the FY24 budget from the Administration department.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorizes the purchase of a used vehicle from GovDeals in a not to-exceed amount of \$20,000.



PURPOSE:

The purpose of this resolution is to authorize staff to purchase a used vehicle from GovDeals for staff usage.

BACKGROUND:

The City's staff frequently utilizes a City vehicle to run errands (i.e. bank, post office, etc.) or to attend conferences, meetings, etc. in lieu of using their personal vehicle. The City is a member of GovDeals and in reviewing existing auctions, we can purchase a used vehicle for less than \$20,000 that would be adequate to meet needs.

Staff requests authorization from the BOMA to purchase a vehicle from GovDeals in a not to- exceed amount of \$20,000.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The funding for the purchase will be made from the FY24 budget from the Administration department.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:
