

RESOLUTION 23-240

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A SPECIAL CENSUS TO DETERMINE THE
CURRENT POPULATION OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has experienced significant growth since the 2020 Federal Census; and

WHEREAS, the City receives shared revenue from the State of Tennessee based on the City's per capita in the amount of \$169.29 per person; and

WHEREAS, the growth between 2020 and 2024 warrants a special census be conducted to determine the current population which could mean a notable increase in revenue for the City; and

WHEREAS, the efforts to complete the special census will be conducted by in-house staff.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorizes a special census to determine the current population of the City of Spring Hill and that the census process begin after the adoption of this Resolution.

RE: To authorize a special census to determine the current
 population of the City

BACKGROUND:

The City has experienced significant growth since the Federal census of 2020, at which time the population was 50,005 citizens. The State of TN distributes shared revenues based on the city's per capita at a rate of \$169.29 per capita. Staff believes the increase of citizens warrants a special census to determine the updated population count which could lead to a notable increase in revenues from the State. In-house staff will be utilized to conduct the census and compile the data. South Central Tennessee Development District is the entity required for verification of data prior to being sent in to the State for final approval.

Significant dates of the proposed schedule:

Letter to the State of intent to perform the census – Due by January 1, 2024

Official start of census – January 1, 2024

Results to SCTDD for verification – March 1, 2024

Deadline to submit special census documentation to the state – May 15, 2024

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Estimated cost is for an amount not-to-exceed \$50,000.
