

RESOLUTION 23-251

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A REFERENDUM TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY AND TO INCORPORATE THE SAME WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, AND TO APPROVE A PLAN OF SERVICES

(2860 Clark Road, Williamson County Tax Map 170, Parcel 009.00, 24.86 acres)

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, upon its own initiative, is examining the extension of its corporate limits by the potential annexation of certain territory adjoining its existing boundaries by referendum; to wit: 2860 Clark Road, Williamson County Tax Map 170, Parcel 009.00 consisting of 24.86 acres, and

WHEREAS, a Plan of Services addressing the services and timing of services as required in Tennessee Code Annotated 6-51-102, has been drafted and requires review and recommendation by the Planning

WHEREAS, a Plan of Services addressing the services and timing of services as required in Tennessee Code Annotated § 6-51-102, has been drafted and requires review and recommendation by the planning commission; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee as follows:

A. That the Maury County Election Commission is hereby requested to conduct a referendum election for the annexation of territory into the boundaries of the City of Spring Hill for qualified voters within the subject territory, to wit:

2860 Clark Road, Williamson County Tax Map 170, Parcel 009.00, 24.86 acres

B. That the plan of services for this territory which is attached as *Exhibit A* hereto is approved and the same is hereby adopted, becoming operative thirty (30) days following certification by the election commission that the annexation was approved.

C. That the *City Manager* shall cause a copy of this resolution, as well as the adopted plan of services, to be forwarded to the Mayor of Williamson County.

D. That a copy of the election certification shall be sent to the mayor of Williamson County upon receipt from the election commission.

E. That a copy of this resolution shall be recorded with the Williamson County Register of Deeds, and a copy shall also be sent to the Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury and the County Assessor of Property, following certification by the election commission that the annexation was approved.

F. That a copy of this resolution, as well as the portion of the plan of services related to emergency services and a detailed map of the annexed area, shall be sent to any affected emergency communication district, following certification by the election commission that the annexation was approved.

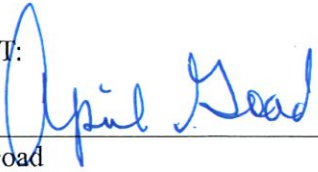
G. That a revised map of the voting precincts shall be sent to the office of local government and to the office of management information services for the Tennessee General Assembly, following certification by the election commission that the annexation was approved.

I. That the Tennessee Department of Revenue shall be notified, for the purpose of tax administration, that the annexation took place.

WHEREUPON, the Mayor declared the Resolution adopted, affixed a signature and the date thereto, and directed that the same be recorded.
