**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TABLE OF FEES IN THE SPRING HILL
MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 5, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 5-104**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, established Title 5, Chapter 1, Section 5-104 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, have adopted Ordinance 23-19 pertaining to the adoption of the electrical code along with the assessment of associated fees; and

WHEREAS, to ensure compliance and effective implementation of the provisions within the Spring Hill Municipal Code, it is imperative to maintain a comprehensive fee table that corresponds to the Spring Hill Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen, do hereby modify the fee table as per the requirements set forth in Title 5, Chapter 1, Section 5-104 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code as provided in the attached fee table denoted as Appendix A.





RE: Resolution 24-02: Updated FY 24 Fee Table for Electrical Inspections

PURPOSE:

Resolution 24-02 provides the updated listing of fees to include electrical fees. The updated table provides for the addition of electric fees as allowed in Ordinance 23-19.

BACKGROUND:

Ordinance 23-19 provides for the adoption of electrical codes. Associated fees are set and modified via resolution pursuant to Spring Hill Municipal Code § 5-104 ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES, FINES, CHARGES, AND RATES.

Additionally, there is a correction to the previously adopted table for an existing reinspection fee contained in § 18-315. Those fees are contained in the provided table to address the oversight during the first adoption. These fee amounts were not modified from the previously set amount per this resolution.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Impacts of the current fee structure are not currently calculated via this proposed resolution. Additional analysis regarding financial impact and determination of rates being proposed are provided in a separate staff report.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen approve Resolution 24-02 as provided.
