**A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A TENNESSEE HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE GRANT
TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Police Departments Traffic Unit participates with the Tennessee Highway Safety Office with traffic enforcement and educational programs; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has been awarded a \$79,789.00 grant from the Tennessee Highway Safety Office, Z24THS271, Community-Based Traffic Safety Enforcement and Education, to be used through September 30th, 2024; and

WHEREAS, funding is allocated to pay for overtime in salaries for traffic enforcement programs, (\$25,000.00), Supplies and Capital, (\$54,789.00) by the Spring Hill Police Department; and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required to receive this funding.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Alderman accepts the Tennessee Highway Safety Office grant, Z24THS271, Community Based Traffic Safety Enforcement and Education, of \$79,789.00 to be used by the Police Department towards Overtime Salaries, Supplies and Capital Purchases.


