

RESOLUTION 24-69

A Resolution in Support of Utilizing Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Grant Funds for the Construction of a Replacement Bridge on Jim Warren Road over Interstate 65

WHEREAS the City of Spring Hill recognizes the critical importance of infrastructure improvements for the benefit of the Citizens of Spring Hill and prosperity of our community; and

WHEREAS the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law presents an opportunity to address vital infrastructure needs across the nation, including the improvement of bridges and roadways; and

WHEREAS the Jim Warren Road bridge over Interstate 65 serves as a crucial access point to the Spring Hill Commerce Center, a forthcoming industrial project anticipated to span 5.7 million square feet, generating numerous well-paying jobs for the residents of Spring Hill and Maury County and serving as a positive stimulus to the local economy; and


WHEREAS the existing bridge on Jim Warren Road is in need of replacement to ensure safe and efficient transportation for the expected with the development of the Spring Hill Commerce Center; and

WHEREAS, securing funding through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law to finance the construction of a replacement bridge on Jim Warren Road over Interstate 65 aligns with the goals of enhancing infrastructure, promoting economic development, and creating job opportunities within the City of Spring Hill and Maury County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, as follows:

- The Board hereby expresses its full support for utilizing the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law to fund the construction of a replacement bridge on Jim Warren Road over Interstate 65.
- The Board hereby directs the appropriate city officials to take all necessary steps to pursue and secure the funding through the Biden Bipartisan Infrastructure Law grant for the construction of the replacement bridge.
- The Board hereby authorizes the Mayor, City Administration, and other Spring Hill Commerce Center stakeholders to communicate this Resolution to relevant federal agencies, elected officials, and other interested parties to advocate for the allocation of funds for the construction of the replacement bridge on Jim Warren Road over Interstate 65.


