**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF PEDESTRIAN PUSH
BUTTONS FOR SEVEN CITY INTERSECTIONS THROUGH A SOLE SOURCE
VENDOR**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Traffic Department desires to purchase Polara Push Buttons through a Sole Source Vendor; and

WHEREAS, currently seven city intersections still have the originally installed push buttons which are in either need of replacement or are not ADA compliant; and

WHEREAS, the intersections in need of replacement are Port Royal Road at Duplex, Commonwealth at Duplex, Miles Johnson at Duplex, Hwy 31 at Duplex, Miles Johnson at Hwy 31, Port Royal at Kroger, and Port Royal at Reserve; and

WHEREAS, the sole source vendor that carries Polara Push Buttons is Temple, Inc., and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of the Polara Push Buttons is currently budgeted in the traffic division (110-43120-54232 - \$50,123.00).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen, authorize the purchase of Polara Pedestrian Push Buttons from Temple, Inc not to exceed a total price of \$50,123.00.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this resolution is to approve the purchase of pedestrian push buttons for seven city intersections through sole source.

BACKGROUND:

The City is currently in need of pedestrian push buttons to replace the originally installed Intellicross push buttons at seven intersections due to age, lack of warranty and issues with ADA compliance. Temple is the sole source vendor for the Polara buttons. The installation of the new push buttons would bring the intersections into compliance. The intersections being replaced are Port Royal at Duplex, Commonwealth at Duplex, Miles Johnson at Duplex, Hwy 31 at Duplex, Miles Johnson at Hwy 31, Port Royal at Reserve, and Port Royal at Kroger.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The funding for the truck will be from the Traffic Department (110-43120-54232). Budgeted funds are \$50,123.00.

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 24-284 to approve the purchase of pedestrian push buttons through Temple, Inc., a sole source vendor.
