

RESOLUTION 24-299

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE AND RENTAL OF NEEDED MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT TO COMPLETE FIRE TRAINING SITE

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Fire Department operates a career fire department that responds to all hazards within the city; and

WHEREAS; the Fire Department uses space at the Public Works Facility located at 3893 Mahlon Moore Rd. for fire and rescue training; and

WHEREAS; the department was given permission to relocate to a larger site on the same property which will provide for greater space and training flexibility including the addition of new and improved props including a training tower; and

WHEREAS, Public Works has provided all site work to include grading, sloping, and compacting of the ground, surveying, marking and will handle paving and project close-out.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen to approve the purchase of blacktop materials, rental of additional dump trucks, and the purchase of any additional parts, materials, or supplies necessary to complete the project to specifications, by using city-contracted vendors, not to exceed \$94,236.75 with budget money allocated in the FY24 Capital Projects Fund 313-48999-59125.

RE: Completion of Fire Training Ground Site Work

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this resolution is to authorize Public Works to purchase the necessary materials, supplies, and accessories and to rent dump truck(s) in order to complete the paving and site prep for the fire training site located at Public Works.

BACKGROUND:

The Fire Department needs additional space for the purpose of Fire and Rescue Training. The goal was to move the training grounds to the new Community Service Annex; however, that is now projected to take between 3-5 years thus requiring the expansion at the current location. Prop re-alignment and the addition of a training tower are advantageous for numerous reasons including an improved ISO rating. The FY24 Budget included \$766,734.00 towards the project, of which only less than half will need to be used. An additional \$94,236.75 included in this request to covers the materials, rentals

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Capital Projects Fund 313-48999-59125

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 24-299 to allow Public Works to expend \$94,236.75 of the Capital Projects Fund 313-48999-59125 assigned to the Fire Training Site for the completion of the ground work, paving, and remaining site prep necessary to make the area usable.


