

ORDINANCE 15-22

AN ORDINANCE TO REALIGN ALDERMANIC WARDS IN THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, PURSUANT TO TENN. CODE ANN. §6-3-102

WHEREAS, the last Aldermanic Ward Realignment took place in 2006. Due to the tremendous population growth the City has experienced since 2006, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen now seeks to update the ward regions based on the 2014 Special Census;

WHEREAS, Tenn. Code Ann. §6-3-101 authorizes the Board of Mayor and Aldermen to realign wards, but same shall be accomplished only by ordinance passed by a two-third ($\frac{2}{3}$) vote of the entire membership to which the Board is entitled, along with a number of additional criteria specified by said statute;


WHEREAS, the Mayor of Spring Hill, Tennessee, appointed a Ward Realignment Task Force to study possible ward realignment options and provide a recommendation to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen with regards to same;

WHEREAS, Ward Realignment Option One (1) (attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein as if separately set forth) contains two (2) planned wards in both Williamson and Maury Counties each for a total of four (4) aldermanic wards in the City. The 2014 census population is distributed proportionality through all four (4) potential aldermanic wards;

WHEREAS, the Ward Realignment Task Force recommends adoption of Option One (1) for ward realignment, finding it to be the most fair and equitable among the four (4) potential options;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL that the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, hereby adopts Ward Realignment Option 1A, which shall take effect at the next City of Spring Hill election on April 6, 2017, as recommended by the Ward Realignment Task Force and otherwise in conformity with Tenn. Code Ann. §6-3-101.






***Current Wards with 2014 Special Census




***Base revisions by 2014 Special Census
