

**ORDINANCE 15-29**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 86-47, THE SAME BEING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, BY AMENDING ARTICLE IV, SECTION 5, AUTOMOBILE STORAGE, TO INCLUDE PROVISIONS FOR BICYCLE PARKING RACKS**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and the general laws of the State of Tennessee, have right to enact an amend the Spring Hill Zoning Ordinance 86-47. Said amendments being within the adopted Comprehensive Plan purpose of promoting the public health, safety, morals, convenience, order, prosperity, and general welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Spring Hill Municipal Planning Commission has created a precedent of promoting safe and orderly development standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Spring Hill Municipal Planning Commission adopted the Bicycle and Greenway Plan, which recommends the adoption of bicycle parking racks standards;

**WHEREAS**, the Spring Hill Municipal Planning Commission has recommended to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2015 to amend Zoning Ordinance 86-47 of the City of Spring Hill, as hereafter described;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN:**

**Section 1.** That Article IV (General Provisions) Section 5 is repealed and replaced as attached hereto.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and same hereby, are repealed or modified as the case may be.


**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption the public welfare requiring it.
