

ORDINANCE 12-11

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE PERTAINING TO SIGN SIZE

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact and amend zoning ordinance regulations in accordance with a comprehensive plan for the purpose of promoting the public health, safety, morals, convenience, order, prosperity, and general welfare of the community;

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Planning Commission approved Resolution 12-15, recommending to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen that the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, be amended as hereafter described;

BE IT THEREFORE NOW ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

THAT; the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, is hereby amended by deleting the flowing sentence in Article XVI, Section 1.3.2 Item #3 (Under Attached Signs):

“A. Maximum sign area shall be one (1) square foot per linear foot of building frontage.”

And replace with:

“A. Maximum sign area shall be one (1) square foot per linear foot of building side, excluding rear of building. Each side shall be calculated independently with one sign allowed per side based on the calculation for that side.”

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that any ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.




