

**ORDINANCE NO. 09-15**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 18, CHAPTER 1,  
SECTION 18-108 OF THE  
SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill desires to amend the Municipal Code so as to amend Title 18, Chapter 1, Section 18-108.

**WHEREAS**, that Title 18, Chapter 1, Section 18-108 be amended by adding the following paragraph at the end of that section that will read as follows:

*“That beginning on May 18th, 2009 a separate water tap shall be required for all residential, agricultural, industrial and commercial irrigation systems, that such tap will be the exclusive way to measure water consumption for such irrigation systems. The fee for such water tap shall be determined by the appropriate fee schedule contained in this Chapter.”*

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED**, that Title 18, Chapter 1, Section 18-108 be amended by adding the foregoing language at an additional paragraph at the end of that section.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that all ordinances or potential ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed or modified as the case may be.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare demanding it.


