

**ORDINANCE 01-48**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 1, SECTION 1-105,  
PARAGRAPH 2, TERMS OF OFFICE, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE  
OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill may, pursuant to it's charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health, and safety of it's citizens.


**BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF  
MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL,  
TENNESSEE:**

That Section 1-105, Paragraph 2, be deleted in its entirety and inserted in its stead thereof; "At the regular election scheduled for the year 1999, four (4) aldermen, one from each ward, shall be elected for four (4) year terms. Thereafter, municipal elections shall be conducted every two (2) years at which time four (4) aldermen, one (1) from each ward, shall be elected for a four year term.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** that any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed or changed accordingly.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that this ordinance shall take effect from and after it's adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
