

ORDINANCE NO. 01-51

**AMENDMENT OF THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE
REQUIRING COVERAGE OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, debris from uncovered motor vehicles is causing an enhanced danger to public safety in the City of Spring Hill.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desires to amend the Municipal Code so as to impose a requirement that certain motor vehicles, and/or trailers, be covered within the city limits.


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, be it hereby ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the Spring Hill Municipal Code is hereby amended to include a provision as follows:

1. **Covered Vehicles.** It shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle, and/or trailer, which transports litter, crushed stone, fill dirt and rock, soil, bulk sand, coal, phosphate, muck, concrete debris, other building materials, agricultural lime or loose material to transport these items unless hauling in an enclosed space or fully covered by a tarpaulin. "Loose material" includes any substance which could spill, drop off, or blow away from the open bed when the vehicle is operated. A violation of this provision shall result in the imposition of a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) fine.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that all ordinances or partial ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby, are repealed or modified as the case may be.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage the public welfare demanding it.
