

**ORDINANCE NO. 00-27**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN PROPERTY OF BARRY AND  
JANICE DABNEY, SUCH PROPERTY FRONTS ON PORT ROYAL  
ROAD AND DERRYBERRY ROAD AS SHOWN ON MAURY COUNTY  
TAX MAP 44, PARCELS 5.02, 5.03, 5.04, CONSISTING OF 18 ACRES,  
MORE OR LESS**

**WHEREAS**, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the City of Spring Hill and the affected territory will be materially retarded unless the territory is annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Spring Hill, and;

**WHEREAS**, the property owner listed in this Ordinance 00-27 has requested annexation in order to insure the value and availability of her property to future developers, and

**WHEREAS**, the natural growth area of the City of Spring Hill will include these parcels

**BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE** that:

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Section 6-51-101 et seq., the property vested in property owners as hereinafter listed in Maury County, Tennessee being a part of Maury County Tax map 44, parcel 5.02, 5.03, 5.04, fronting on Port Royal Road and Derrybery Road, consisting of 18 acres, more or less, is hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Spring Hill and made a part thereof.


Annexation of said territory adjoining the City's existing boundaries is necessary for the welfare of the affected territory as well as the City as a whole.

A map showing the said territory is available for inspection at City Hall in Spring Hill, Tennessee.



This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its final passage.


