

ORDINANCE NO. 99-7

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 96-30 CREATING A
DEDICATED FUND FOR THE SPRING HILL POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Whereas, the intent of this Ordinance was to provide a special fund for traffic equipment and other uses for the Police Department; and

Whereas, the revenue was provided from a portion of traffic citations issued by the Department; and

Whereas, the fund has not worked as intended and creates a bookkeeping entry that is not necessary and is redundant

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL,
TENNESSEE**, that Ordinance No. 96-30 is hereby repealed and any balance in the fund be transferred to the General Fund as City Court revenues.
