

ORDINANCE NO. 99-25

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE
REGULATIONS OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, TO
RESTRICT THE PLACEMENT OF CELL PHONE TOWERS**

Whereas, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the Town of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact and amend zoning ordinance regulations in accordance with a comprehensive plan for the purpose of promoting the public health, safety, morals, convenience, order, prosperity, and general welfare of the community.

**BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR
AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:**


(1) That Article VIII, Section 1.1(15) and of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, is hereby amended by substituting in its place the following: Cellular telephone towers or structures.

And


(2) That Article VIII, Section 1.1 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection: 1.1(17) Accessory uses or structures customarily incidental to permitted uses 1.1(9) to 1.1(16).

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.


