

ORDINANCE NO. 99-43

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN
OF SPRING HILL TO ESTABLISH THE AMOUNT OF FINES AND
PENALTIES FOR ILLEGAL PARKING**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the Town of Spring Hill may, pursuant to its charter and general laws of the State of Tennessee, enact regulatory ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, health and safety of its citizens.


**BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR
AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:**

(1) That Title 15, Chapter 6, Section 15-705, Paragraph 2, be amended to delete Paragraph 2 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following paragraph:

(2) Parking Citations. For Parking Violations, the offender may waive his right to a judicial hearing and have the charges disposed of out of court, by satisfying a civil penalty of \$10.00 for each citation issued.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.


