

ORDINANCE NO. 98-41

**AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX FROM MAURY COUNTY, TENNESSEE
A PORTION OF PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the Town of Spring Hill and the affected territory known as lot fronting on Kedron Road and Hunters Pointe Subdivision, Maury County, Parcel 12 and on Tax Map 43 of the Tax Assessor's Record be annexed to the corporate limits of the Town on Spring Hill, and

WHEREAS, the natural growth of the Town of Spring Hill will include the parcels as known to this Ordinance , and

WHEREAS, this annexed property will be bordered on the sides by property within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Spring Hill.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Section 6-51-101 et seq., the property described are hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill and made a part thereof.

Annexation of said property adjoining the City's existing boundaries is necessary for the welfare of the affected territory as well as of the City as a whole.

A map showing the said territory is available for inspection at the City Recorder's Office.

This ordinance was passed after the adoption of a plan of services for the property in conformity with and as provided by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-51-102.

This ordinance was passed on second reading after a public hearing before the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on January 19, 1999, and after due publication.
