

**ORDINANCE NO. 98-43**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE  
ZONING ORDINANCES TO CLARIFY DUSTLESS PARKING AREAS**

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a need exists to clarify sections of the Spring Hill Zoning Ordinance to require dustless parking provisions in all areas zoned as M-1.

Be it ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill:

SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the Zoning Ordinance for the Town of Spring Hill are revised as follows:


On all properties zoned business, commercial, or industrial, all off-street parking for any vehicle shall be on areas paved with asphalt or concrete or upon which a 4-inch base of gravel exists.


