

**AN ORDINANCE TO REDEFINE AND SET TRAFFIC SPEED LIMITS
ALONG THE ARTERIAL STREETS AND ROADS OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL
TO INCLUDE U.S. ROUTE 31, STATE ROUTE 247 AND KEDRON ROAD**

Whereas, there have been recurring complaints from motorists about the poor condition of traffic signs in Spring Hill;

Whereas, growth in traffic volume has precipitated a review of existing traffic speed limits and signs for same along arterial streets and roads;

Whereas, Kedron Road should now be considered a minor arterial because of residential growth and an impending golf course cluster development;

Whereas, the image of Spring Hill is suffering as a result of poor regulatory sign location, sometimes an absence of signs where needed for public notice, and the dilapidated condition of traffic signs; and

Whereas, the governing board deems it to be a good and fair policy for the motoring public to have adequate and highly visible notice of traffic laws in Spring Hill.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the following traffic speed limits shall be the law of the Town of Spring Hill:

Section 1. A speed limit of 30 mph shall be in effect in the following locations:

(a) On Route 31 (Main Street) from the mid point between First Baptist Church and Witt Hill subdivision to the south end of the McCormack Creek Bridge;

(b) On State Route 247 from 200 yards west of the crest of the hill adjacent to the west side of the CSX railroad tracks to the east side of the intersection of East Alex Drive with State Route 247

(c) On Kedron Road from the east end of Orphanage Creek to Route 31.

Section 2. A speed limit of 35 mph shall be in effect in the following locations:

(a) On State Route 247 from the western city limits to the beginning of the 30 mph zone commencing 200 yards west of the crest of the hill adjacent to the west side of the CSX railroad tracks;

(b) On State Route 247 from the eastern city limits to the 30 mph zone at the east end of Newtown at the intersection of East Alex Drive and State Route 247.

Section 3. A speed limit of 45 mph shall be in effect in the following locations:

(a) On Route 31 from the north edge of the "Hitchin Post" tract to the midpoint between First Baptist Church and Witt Hill Subdivision;

(b) On Route 31 from the north end of Route 396 (Saturn Parkway) overpass to the south end of the McCormack Creek Bridge;


(c) On Kedron Road from the southern city limits to the east end of Orphanage Creek Bridge near Jackson subdivision.

Section 4. A speed limit of 55 mph shall be in effect in the following locations:

(a) On Route 31 from the northern city limits to the north edge of the "Hitchin Post" tract;

(b) On Route 31 from the southern city limits to the north end of Route 396 (Saturn Parkway).
