

**AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX THE STATE OF TENNESSEE PROPERTY
IN WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE, BEING
A PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 247
FROM EXISTING CITY LIMITS TO THE EAST EDGE OF ROUTE 247
AND BUCKNER LANE INTERSECTION**

Whereas, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of Spring Hill and the affected territory will be materially retarded unless the territory is annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, that:

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §§ 6-51-101 et seq., the property vested in the State of Tennessee in Williamson County, Tennessee, being a portion of State Route 247 from existing city limits to the east edge of Route 247 and Buckner Lane intersection, is hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill and made a part thereof.

Annexation of said territory adjoining the Town's existing boundaries is necessary for the welfare of the affected territory as well as the Town as a whole.

A map showing the said territory is available for inspection at Town Hall in Spring Hill, Tennessee.

This Ordinance was passed after the adoption of a plan of services for the property in conformity with and as provided by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-51-102.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its final passage.

This Ordinance was passed on second reading after a public hearing held on June 16, 1997, after notice thereof was duly published in the Columbia Daily Herald and the Franklin Review Appeal on 6-1-, 1997.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 16th day of June, 1997.
