

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT
THE 1991 STANDARD SWIMMING POOL CODE OF THE
SOUTHERN BUILDING CODE CONGRESS INTERNATIONAL, INC,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSURING
THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE
IN THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION OR INSTALLATION,
AND REPAIR OR ALTERATION OF
PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SWIMMING POOLS,
AND EQUIPMENT RELATED THERETO**

Whereas, there are an increasing number of private swimming pools being constructed inside the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill due to the increasing number of suburban commuters who choose to live within the corporate limits of the Town; and,

Whereas, the Town is becoming populated with numerous families who currently have small children as well as numerous young married couples beginning families; and,

Whereas, the health, safety, and welfare of small children are of the utmost concern to the citizens of Spring Hill, and the Board of Mayor and Aldermen are compelled to regulate the design, construction, enclosure, and maintenance of public and private swimming pools, the public interest requiring such regulation,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

Section One. Swimming pool code adopted.

Pursuant to authority granted by Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 6-54-501 through 6-54-504, and for the purpose of regulating the design, construction or installation, and repair or alterations of swimming pools, public or private, and equipment related thereto, the Standard Swimming Pool Code, 1991 edition (copyright 1992), as prepared and adopted by (and available for purchase from) the Southern Building Code Congress International, Inc., 900 Montclair Road, Birmingham, Alabama 35213, is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as part of the municipal code of the Town of Spring Hill, and is hereafter referred to as the swimming pool code.

Section Two. Modifications.

Whenever the swimming pool code refers to the "Administrative Authority" or the "Building Official", it shall be deemed to be a reference to the Building Inspector of the Town of Spring Hill or such person as the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has appointed and designated to administer and enforce the provisions of the swimming pool code. The recommended schedule of permit fees set forth in Section 105.6 of the swimming pool code is adopted.

Section Three. Amendments.

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen shall approve any subsequent amendments to the swimming pool code.


Section Four. Available in recorder's office.

Pursuant to the requirements of Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-54-502, one (1) copy of the swimming pool code has been placed on file in the recorder's office and shall be kept there for the use, inspection, and examination of the public.

Section Five. Violations.

It shall be unlawful for any person to violate or fail to comply with any provision of the swimming pool code as herein adopted by reference and modified.
