

ORDINANCE NO. 95-10

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES NO. 86-41,
PART C, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 91-9
AND ORDINANCES 93-11, TO ESTABLISH
WATER AND SEWER RATES FOR THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL FOR CUSTOMERS
LIVING IN THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Spring Hill desires to offer relief to the citizens of Spring Hill in their monthly water and sewer bills; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined sufficient operating reserves exist in the water and sewer funds to provide relief on the basic charge for the first 2,000 gallons of monthly use for both water and sewer services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the following rates be established:

SECTION 1. The established water rates for customers served by the Town of Spring Hill municipal water system within the city limits are as follows:


<u>Gallons per month:</u>	<u>Water Rate Inside City:</u>
First 2,000	\$8.25 (minimum)
Next 3,000	\$2.43 per thousand gal.
Next 5,000	\$2.09 per thousand gal.
Next 10,000	\$1.89 per thousand gal.
Over 20,000	\$1.69 per thousand gal.

SECTION 2. Sewer rates shall be based on actual water meter readings excepting those readings taken from the yard hydrant meters as defined in Ordinance 95-9. The established sewer rates for customers served by the Town of Spring Hill municipal sewer system inside the city limits are as follows:

<u>Gallons per month:</u>	<u>Sewer Rate Inside City:</u>
First 2,000	\$15.00 (minimum)
Next 3,000	\$3.65 per thousand gal.
Next 5,000	\$3.14 per thousand gal.
Next 10,000	\$2.84 per thousand gal.
Over 20,000	\$2.54 per thousand gal.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the billing cycle of _____, 1995.


