

**AN ORDINANCE TO CONTRACT THE CITY LIMITS
OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL
BY THE DE-ANNEXATION OF APPROXIMATELY
232.29 ACRES ON MAHLON MOORE ROAD
OWNED BY JANE SIMMONS AND HER DAUGHTERS
BEING DESIGNATED AS MAURY COUNTY TAX MAP 50, PARCEL 3.03**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

WHEREAS, Jane Simmons, the owner with her children of a tract of land containing approximately 232.29 acres located on Mahlon Moore Road within the city limits of the town of Spring Hill, the same being designated as Maury County Tax Map 50, Parcel 3.03, has requested that the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill be contracted so as to de-annex this property (on which city taxes for the year 1994 were in the amount of \$126.74); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen finds that it is to the best interest of this property that it be de-annexed from its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, notice of this proposed ordinance has been published in the Columbia Daily Herald and Franklin Review Appeal which publication gave notice of a public hearing to be held at 6:55 p.m. on Monday, February 20, 1995, as to this proposed de-annexation; and


WHEREAS, after consideration of the matters raised at the public hearing, the Board has determined to grant the request of the said Jane Simmons;

Now, therefore, BE IT ORDAINED that, pursuant to Section 6-53-201 of Tennessee Code Annotated, the corporate limits of the

Town of Spring Hill be contracted by the de-annexation of the property of Jane Simmons and her children on Mahlon Moore Road designated as Maury County Tax Map 50, Parcel 3.03 containing approximately 232.29 acres.

This ordinance was passed on both readings by a majority of the entire membership of the Board and was passed on final reading after notice and public hearing all as required by Section 6-53-201, Tennessee Code Annotated.

Passed and adopted this 15th day of May, 1995.




