

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SIGNS PROVISIONS OF THE
SPRING HILL ZONING ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 74-2,
TO ALLOW A SIGN CONTAINING SIXTY (60) SQUARE FEET
TO BE ERECTED AND MAINTAINED ON THE PROPERTY ON
WHICH THE SPRING HILL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IS LOCATED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

That Ordinance No. 74-2, the Zoning Ordinance of the Town
of Spring Hill, as the same has been previously amended, is hereby
further amended as follows:


1. By amending Section 10.5 of Article IV by adding at
the end thereof the following:

Class "G" - sixty (60) square feet maximum.

2. By striking from Section 1.7(1) of Article VI the
word "school" and adding at the end thereof the following
paragraph:

(d) Any of the foregoing provisions not
withstanding, on any lot on which a public school
is located there may be erected and maintained a
Class "G"

This Ordinance was passed on the recommendation of the
Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission made at its regular
meeting held on the second Monday of August, 1995, after a public
hearing thereon after due advertisement as provided by the Zoning
Ordinance and Tennessee Code Annotated.




