

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 92-2,
THE BEER ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL
TO ALLOW THE OUTSIDE SALE OF BEER
WITHIN CONFINED PREMISES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

That Ordinance No. 92-2, the same being the beer ordinance of the Town of Spring Hill, is hereby amended by adding at the end of Section 2-222(a)(13) the following:

Provided, however, it shall be lawful to allow the sale or delivery of beer for consumption on the premises outside of the building occupied by the holder of the permit in areas enclosed by a fence or parts of the building so that such consumption is not easy to observe from the nearest street.


