

**AN ORDINANCE TO EXEMPT THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL
FROM LIABILITY FOR SOCIAL SECURITY AND MEDICARE TAXES
ON ELECTION WORKERS AND TO AUTHORIZE
THE MAYOR AND RECORDER TO SIGN AN AMENDMENT
TO THE EXISTING CONTRACT BETWEEN THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL AND THE STATE OF TENNESSEE
OLD AGE AND SURVIVORS INSURANCE AGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

SECTION 1. That the Town of Spring Hill hereby elects to exclude its coverage under the Federal System of Old Age, Survivors, Disability, and Health Insurance, the services of election workers and election officials if the remuneration paid to any individual for such services in a calendar year is less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) on or after January 1, 1995, and ending on or before December 31, 1999, and the adjusted amount thereafter determined under Section 218(c)(8)(B) of the Social Security Act for any calendar year commencing on or after January 1, 2000.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and the Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to sign an amendment to the existing agreement between the Town of Spring Hill and the State Old Age and Survivors Insurance Agency to effectuate this exclusion.
