

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET ORDINANCE
FOR THE YEAR JULY 1, 1994, THROUGH JUNE 30, 1995,
THE SAME BEING ORDINANCE NO. 94-11
BY REDUCING THE REAL ESTATE TAXES BY \$13,087.00
AND REDUCING SALARIES UNDER THE POLICE DEPARTMENT
THE SAME AMOUNT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the
Town of Spring Hill:


That Ordinance No. 94-11, the same being the budget
ordinance for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1994, is amended by
reducing total revenues and total expenditures each \$13,087.00 and
reducing the following items within that ordinance:

1. Under BUDGETED REVENUE under Real Estate Taxes
Current, a reduction of \$13,087.00.

2. A similar reduction in Total Taxes with
appropriate adjustments throughout the revenue section of the
ordinance.

3. By reducing Salaries under POLICE the same
amount of \$13,087.00, and by amending the relative totals within
the expenditure portion of the budget.


