

AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER AMEND
ORDINANCE NO. 92-11, THE BUDGET ORDINANCE
FOR FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1992,
THROUGH JUNE 30, 1993, TO REFLECT
THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF GRANTS FROM
THE STATE OF TENNESSEE
FOR LIBRARY AND BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS
AND TO REFLECT ACTUAL RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES
IN CONNECTION WITH GARBAGE COLLECTION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

That Ordinance No. 92-11, the budget ordinance for the
fiscal year July 1992, through June 30, 1993, as previously amended
by Ordinance No. 93-09, is hereby further amended to reflect funds
received as grants from the State of Tennessee for library and
bridge improvements and for additional garbage collection fees and
their respective expenditures as follows:

1. Under INTERGOVERNMENTAL REVENUE in the REVENUE
section of the ordinance the words and figures pertaining to State
of TN - Grants is hereby amended to read as follows:

2. The total for INTERGOVERNMENTAL REVENUE is
accordingly increased by \$112,000.00 to \$229,152.00.

3. Under HIGHWAYS AND STREETS in the EXPENDITURES
section the words and figures pertaining to Capital Outlay should
be amended to read:

Capital Outlay \$62,000.00

and the total should be increased by a like amount to
\$143,113.00.

4. Under LIBRARY under EXPENDITURES there should be added an entry as follows:

Library Improvements \$52,000.00

The total Library Expenditures should be increased \$52,000.00 to \$57,602.00.

5. Under BUDGETED REVENUE the Sanitation Revenue is increased by collections of \$64,000.00 so that entry shall read as follows:

SANITATION REVENUE

Residential and Commercial Collection ... \$114,117.00


6. Under EXPENDITURES the Sanitation Section shall read as follows:

SANITATION


Residential and Commercial Expenditures . \$111,117.00

7. The Total Budgeted Revenue and Total Budgeted Expenditures are each likewise increased an additional \$176,000.00.

This ordinance shall take effect retroactively upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the recommendation of Joe R. White, who conducted an audit for the fiscal year involved to concur with standard principles of accounting and regulations of the Tennessee State Comptroller's Office.


