

**AN ORDINANCE TO IMPLEMENT CERTAIN PROCEDURES
PERTAINING TO MATTERS BROUGHT BEFORE THE
BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

The following procedures are hereby adopted as rules of
order governing meetings of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen:

(a) Once any matter is brought before and acted on by
the Board of Mayor and Aldermen, no motion, resolution or ordinance
pertaining to the same subject matter may be brought before the
Board for its consideration for a period of six (6) months from the
date of such action subject to the following exceptions:

(1) Any such matter may be brought before the Board
if a petition signed by four (4) members of the Board requesting
such action is filed with the Recorder seventy-two (72) hours prior
to a meeting of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen; or

(2) If the Mayor in his discretion deems that
extraordinary circumstances require a matter to be reconsidered he
may move that the matter be brought before the Board by motion. If
such motion is passed by a majority of the members present, the
matter may be reconsidered by the Board.

(b) There is further established as a rule of order of
the Board of Mayor and Aldermen that no matter may be placed upon
the agenda of any of its meetings except by the Mayor, an Aldermen,
the Recorder or the Town Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the foregoing be codified in the Spring Hill Municipal Code as Sub-sections (a) and (b) of Section 1-104, which Code is hereby accordingly amended.
