

ORDINANCE 93-11

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES NO.91-9 AND NO. 86-41, PART C TO ESTABLISH WATER AND SEWER RATES FOR THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, MAURY COUNTY DISTRICT, HB&TS UTILITY DISTRICT AND CUSTOMERS OUTSIDE THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL WHO ARE SERVED BY THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the water and sewer systems operate in a solvent financial posture; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is necessary to increase water and sewer rates in order to maintain a solvent financial posture;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the following rates be established:

Section 1. The established water rates for customers served by the Town of Spring Hill municipal water system within the city limits are as follow:

<u>Gallons per Month</u>	<u>Water Rate Inside City</u>
First 2,000	\$10.25 (minimum)
Next 3,000	2.43 per thousand gal.
Next 5,000	2.09 " " "
Next 10,000	1.89 " " "
Over 20,000	1.69 " " "

Section 2. The established water rates for customers served by the Town of Spring Hill municipal water system outside the city limits are as follow:

<u>Gallons per Month</u>	<u>Water Rate Outside City</u>
First 2,000	\$12.83 (minimum)
Next 3,000	3.03 per thousand gal.
Next 5,000	2.61 " " "
Next 10,000	2.35 " " "
Over 20,000	2.10 " " "


Section 3. The water rates for the Maury County District are established by contract.

Section 4. The water rates for the HB&TS Utility District are established by contract.

Section 5. Sewer rates shall be based on actual water meter readings. The established sewer rates for customers served by the Town of Spring Hill municipal sewer system inside the city limits are as follow:

<u>Gallons per Month</u>	<u>Sewer Rate Inside City</u>
First 2,000	\$17.00 (minimum)
Next 3,000	3.65 per thousand gal.
Next 5,000	3.14 " " "
Next 10,000	2.84 " " "
Over 20,000	2.54 " " "

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect on the July, 1993 billing, the public welfare requiring it.
