

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL ZONING ORDINANCE  
AND THE ZONING MAP BY THE RECLASSIFICATION  
OF THAT PART OF THE OLD HIGH SCHOOL PROPERTY  
ON THE EAST SIDE OF SCHOOL STREET AND THE  
WEST SIDE OF WALNUT STREET OWNED BY  
RAY WILLIAMS AND WIFE, CINDY C. WILLIAMS,  
FROM A B-4 (CENTRAL BUSINESS) DISTRICT  
TO AN M-1 (LIGHT INDUSTRIAL) DISTRICT**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the  
Town of Spring Hill:

That the Spring Hill Municipal Zoning Ordinance,  
Ordinance No. 74-2, and the zoning map thereby adopted, as both  
have been previously amended, are hereby further amended by the  
reclassification of the properties of Ray Williams and wife, Cindy  
C. Williams, acquired from the Maury County Board of Education on  
the east side of School Street and the west side of Walnut Street  
(being a part of Tax Map 25-0, Group C, Parcel 5) from a B-4  
(Central Business) District to an M-1 (Light Industrial) District.

This ordinance was passed on the recommendation of the  
Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission made at a regular meeting  
held on October 11, 1993, after a public hearing conducted thereon  
held on September 20, 1993, after due publication in the Columbia  
Daily Herald.


