

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL ZONING ORDINANCE  
AND THE ZONING MAP BY THE RECLASSIFICATION  
OF THAT PART OF THE OLD HIGH SCHOOL PROPERTY  
LOCATED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF DUPLEX ROAD  
AND THE WEST SIDE OF WALNUT STREET  
OWNED BY CLIFTON AND STERLING MARLIN  
FROM AN R-1 (LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL) DISTRICT  
TO AN M-1 (LIGHT INDUSTRIAL) DISTRICT**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the  
Town of Spring Hill:

That the Spring Hill Municipal Zoning Ordinance,  
Ordinance No. 74-2, and the zoning map thereby adopted, as both  
have been previously amended, are hereby further amended by the  
reclassification of the property of Clifton and Sterling Marlin  
acquired from the Maury County Board of Education on the south side  
of Duplex Road and the west side of Walnut Street (being a part of  
Tax Map 25-0, Group C, Parcel 5) from an R-1 (Low Density  
Residential) District to an M-1 (Light Industrial) District.

This ordinance was passed on the recommendation of the  
Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission made at a regular meeting  
held on September 13, 1993, after a public hearing conducted  
thereon held on October 18, 1993, after due publication in the  
Columbia Daily Herald.


