

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX THE PROPERTIES OF MR. AND  
MRS. W. B. HOOTEN ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE OLD KEDRON PIKE  
(TAX MAP 28, PARCEL 3 AND 4.01) ON THE OLD KEDRON  
PIKE TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL

WHEREAS, W. B. Hooten and wife, the owners of  
properties designated as Tax Map 28, Parcels 3 and 4.01 on the  
East margin of the Old Kedron Pike, have petitioned the Board of  
Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that their property  
be annexed to its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen  
of the Town of Spring Hill, that the prosperity of the Town of  
Spring Hill and the property owned by W. B. Hooten and wife, on  
the Old Kedron Road, will be materially retarded and the safety  
and welfare of the inhabitants and the property thereof  
endangered unless this property is annexed to the corporate  
limits of the Town of Spring Hill;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor

B. Hooten and wife, on the east margin of the Old Kedron Pike

4.01) on the Old Kedron Pike be annexed to and become a part of  
the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill.


