
AN ORDINANCE TO DELETE SECTION 4 OF ARTICLE V OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE SO AS TO ELIMINATE THE PRESENT R-3, HIGH-DENSITY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT PROVISIONS


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL:


1. That the Municipal Zoning Ordinance of the Town of Spring Hill, the same being Ordinance No. 74-2, as previously amended, is hereby further amended by deleting and repealing all of the provisions of Section 4 of Article V.

2. That the R-3, High-Density Residential District provisions of the Ordinance, are hereby deleted therefrom. All references in the Municipal Zoning Ordinance to R-3 on R-3 districts are hereby deleted.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on final reading on the recommendation of the Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission made at its regular meeting on September 11, 1989, and after a public hearing held at 6:45 p.m., September 18, 1989, the notice of which was published more than 15 days prior thereto in the Columbia Daily Herald and the Spring Hill Morning Sun.
