

ORDINANCE NO. 88-16

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE NEXT MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND DETERMINING THE LENGTH OF THE TERM OF THE ALDERMEN ELECTED FROM EACH WARD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

Section 1. That the next municipal election for the election of Mayor and Aldermen, is hereby scheduled for Saturday, May 13, 1989.


Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, pursuant to Section 6-401 of Tennessee Code Annotated, that there shall be elected at this election a Mayor to serve for a period of two (2) years and two (2) Aldermen from each ward, one to serve for a period of one (1) year and other, for a period of two (2) years.

Section 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the candidate receiving the highest number of votes in each ward shall be elected for the two (2) year term, and the candidate receiving the next highest number in each ward, shall be elected for the one (1) year term.

Section 4. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that these officers so elected shall take office on the 3rd Monday in May of 1989.

Section 5. The County Election Commission is hereby requested to hold this election at the new City Hall in Spring Hill, on the day above set forth and to issue all necessary notices.


