

ORDINANCE NO. 86-15

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CORPORATE  
LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF  
THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

WHEREAS, a majority of the residents and property  
owners of the areas in Williamson County hereinafter described  
have petitioned the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of  
Spring Hill that these areas be annexed to its corporate limits;  
and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen  
of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of  
Spring Hill and the territory hereinafter described which is pro-  
posed to be annexed by this Ordinance will be materially retarded  
and the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and property  
thereof endangered unless this territory is annexed to the corp-  
orate limits of the Town of Spring Hill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR  
AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL that the following des-  
cribed areas in Williamson County be annexed to and become a part  
of the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill, to-wit:

1. Tax Map 167, Parcel 2 (Werthan)
2. Tax Map 167, Parcel 2.01 (Purdy)
3. Tax Map 167, Parcel 4 (Mitchum)
4. Tax Map 167, Parcel 5 and Parcel 5.01 (Early)
5. Tax Map 167, Parcel 5.02 (Werthan)
6. Tax Map 167, Parcel 12 (Harvey)
7. Tax Map 167, Parcel 17 (Campbell)
8. Tax Map 167, Parcel 17.01 (White)

9. Tax Map 167, Parcel 17.02 & Parcel 17.03 (Campbell)
10. Tax Map 167, Parcel 18 (Hall)
11. All portions of U. S. Highway 31 from Mitchum's North boundary line (Parcel 4) southwardly to the present city limits and all of the Duplex Road from Campbell's East boundary line (Parcel 17) Westwardly to the present city limits.

The areas set out above are described by the map and parcel number designations as set forth in the records of the office of the Williamson County Assessor of Properties. A map showing these areas is available for inspection at the City Hall in Spring Hill, Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen deem the annexation of the above described property to be necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners of the area annexed hereby as well as the municipality as a whole.

This Ordinance was passed on third reading after a public hearing was held on April 21, 1986, upon the question of this annexation after notice thereof was duly published in the Daily Herald of Columbia, Tennessee on April 10, 1986.

This Ordinance was further adopted after the adoption of a Plan of Services for these areas in conformity with and as provided by §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become operative thirty (30) days after the final passage thereof.


