

ORDINANCE 86-47

AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER AMEND THE MUNICIPAL ZONING  
ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 74-2, TO CONFIRM THE  
MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF  
THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

That the Municipal Zoning Ordinance, Ordinance No. 74-  
2, as previously amended, is hereby further amended so that  
Section 1 of Article XIV will read as follows:


"A Board of Zoning Appeals is hereby created pursuant  
to Section 13-7-205 of Tennessee Code Annotated. The  
Planning Commission of the Town of Spring Hill shall  
serve as the Board of Zoning Appeals until its  
membership is otherwise provided for by Ordinance."

This amendment was approved by the Spring Hill Regional  
Planning Commission at its regular meeting held on October 13,  
1986, and was passed on third reading by the Board of Mayor and  
Aldermen on October 20, 1986, after a public hearing held earlier  
on October 20, 1986, after notice thereof was published in the  
Daily Herald and in the Spring Hill Morning Sun on September 24,  
1986.


